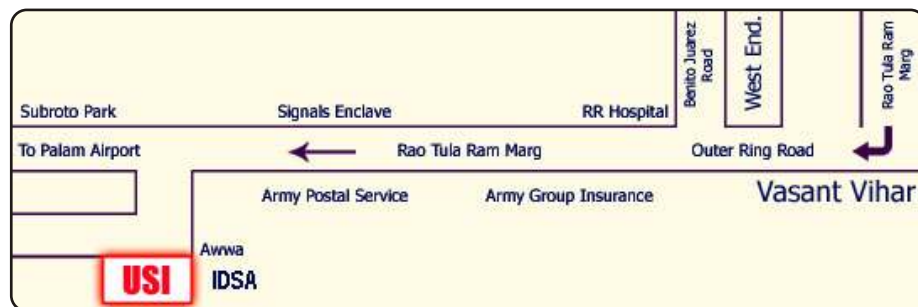
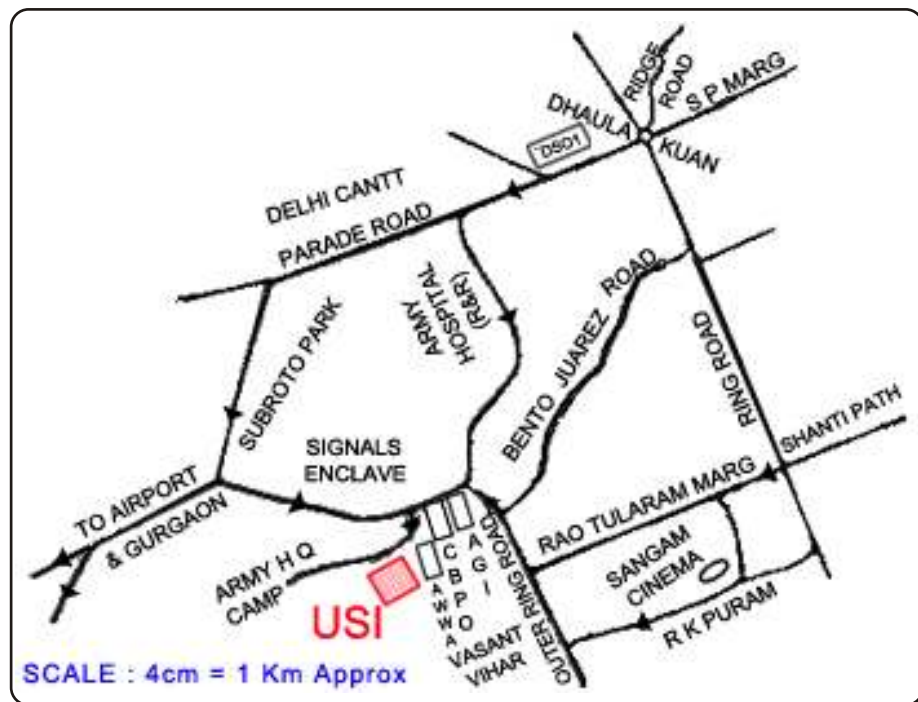

DTC Bus Details

If you arrive at New Delhi Railway Station, walk to New Delhi Metro Station. Take DTC bus no. 781 to Rao Tularam Marg at AWWA (Army Wives Welfare Association) bus stop. From Old Delhi Railway Station or ISBT, take bus no. 729. Get down at Signals Enclave Bus Stop on Rao Tularam Marg. Take the overhead pedestrian bridge to cross the road. USI is about half km walk from Rao Tula Ram Marg. USI Gate is on the left, adjacent to AWWA.
